Respect

Any person found to be repeatedly posting inappropriate content will be barred from access and if necessary, unlawful and fraudulent contributions may be referred to the police.
- OLMC Parramatta reserves the right to remove posts or comments which:
 - use threatening, abusive, violent or otherwise inflammatory language
 - are discriminatory, racist, sexually explicit, vulgar or offensive
 - are unlawful and/or defamatory
 - are infringements of a third party intellectual property, privacy or publicity rights
 - Are false or misleading, including the impersonation of other people
 - contain spam, corrupt files or viruses
 - are not considered in the interests of the OLMC Parramatta community
 - users are not authorised to post.

Privacy
